Glenelg Police Station Hours (increase during summer)

A premier tourism destination like Glenelg needs a strong police presence and that includes a physical police shop front that is open for more than business hours during the peak holiday season. The Marshall Government delivered on another local election commitment by increasing operating hours at the Glenelg Police Station during peak times. This increase in operating hours during summer assists residents and tourists alike to feel safe and enjoy our vibrant community.

Plympton Oval

The Marshall Government has delivered \$100,000 of funding to see another election promise fulfilled. This has enabled the Plympton Sporting and Recreation Club to upgrade community sporting facilities, improve drainage and playing surfaces at the oval. With growing numbers of girls teams, this sporting upgrade encourages more locals to participate.

The Repat

The Marshall Government promised to create a genuine health care precinct at The Repat site, and we have delivered on that promise. The State Government is committed to returning the Repat site to a thriving health precinct, with plans in place to establish a specialist dementia care facility, brain and spinal rehabilitation units, mental health services and a veterans' wellbeing centre. The Repat site is an important part of South Australia's health infrastructure.

Glenelg Primary School Bollards

Safety bollards to protect children and staff at Glenelg Primary School have been installed along Diagonal Rd outside the school's main oval. With over 100,000 vehicles driving past each day, the Glenelg Primary School safety bollards complement the recent improvement to the pedestrian crossing warning signs.

Record infrastructure spend creating thousands of jobs

- Our \$12.9 billion pipeline of infrastructure projects is creating thousands of jobs
- The North-South corridor is progressing with the Northern Connector and Darlington Interchange sections open in early 2020

DEFENCE AND SPACE



In 2018 Prime Minister Scott Morrison, alongside the Premier Steven Marshall, announced that the Australian Space Agency was to be based in Adelaide at Lot Fourteen.

Fast forward to 2020 and the Australian Space Agency is now open. This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity that positions South Australia as a key player in the nation's space industry.

South Australia plays a crucial role in Australia's space economy by contributing to national space infrastructure through:

- A dedicated space precinct in Adelaide's newest precinct Lot Fourteen, incorporating the Australian Space Agency, Mission Control Centre and Space Discovery Centre;
- Future polar and sun-synchronous launch capability.

Lot Fourteen will also soon be home to the headquarters of the SmartSat Cooperative Research Centre, as well as the future Mission Control Facility and Space Discovery Centre.

The Mission Control Centre will be a focal point for space missions in Australia and accelerate growth of the space sector. The Space Discovery Centre will provide science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) education, engagement and inspiration for young Australians.

These are exciting fields that will be a key driver of future jobs for young South Australians.
