

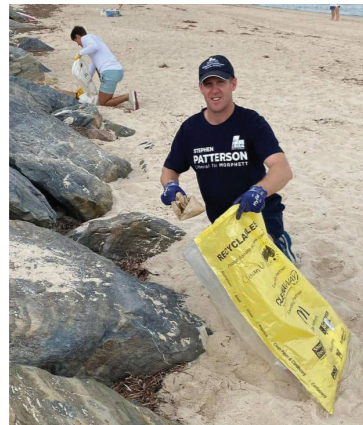

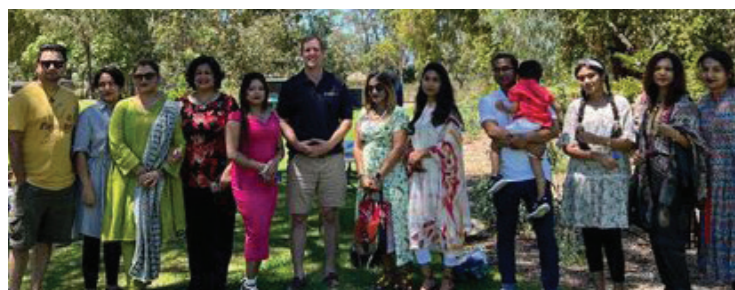

## A note from Stephen

Thank you to all the Morphett residents for once again choosing me as your local State MP. My family and I live and volunteer in Morphett, which has kept me in close contact with the issues our community faces and I will continue to advocate for projects, initiatives and policies which will improve our beautiful suburbs.

The recent State election saw a change of government. As Minister for Trade and Investment in the former government, I am proud that we were able to deliver a number of key projects in South Australia.

The abolition of payroll tax assisted small business and the development of Lot Fourteen helped make SA the national leader in space, defence and cyber. Investments in critical infrastructure, including 'Reactivating the Repat' locally, will be important for our future. While the last 2 years heavily impacted both our personal and professional lives, many in our community felt we were living in one of the safest places in the world during the global covid pandemic.

## Glenelg Beach Disability Access Ramp

As a result, I worked with the former Government to provide \$50,000 to the City of Holdfast Bay as part of a joint funding for a universal access ramp and beach mat on Glenelg Beach.

## William Kibby VC Veterans Shed

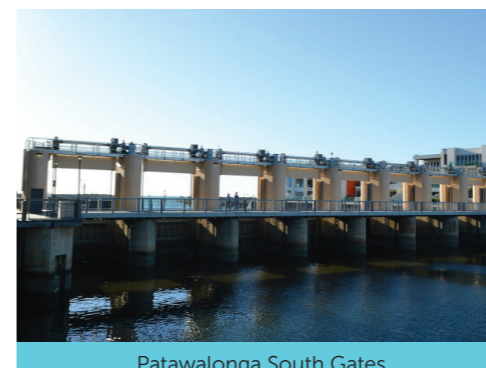

The Patawalonga Southern Gates, built in 1960, are receiving a much-needed upgrade thanks to \$7 million budgeted by the former State Government in the 2021 Budget.

# HOMELESSNESS & ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ROUNDTABLE

Since my election in 2018, I have established a "Homelessness & Anti-Social Behaviour Roundtable" to ensure we have a collaborative approach to community safety matters around the Jetty Road precinct and the surrounding area.

Stakeholders include SA Police, SA Housing Authority, City of Holdfast Bay, St Andrews by the Sea Church, Jetty Road Traders, among others.

This Roundtable has facilitated the expansion of CCTV capability in key areas in Glenelg, to allow for improved identification of offenders and SAPOL have provided security and anti-theft training to Jetty Road traders.
